
4. The Gauntlet



Instructions

Students sit or stand opposite one another in pairs. Each student has a mini whiteboard. The teacher poses a question with multiple possible correct answers and students take turns to provide responses by writing them on their whiteboard and then showing their partner/opponent. Once one student shows their answer, it is the other person's turn.

Students continue this cycle until one of the pair cannot provide a correct answer. The other student is the winner of the round. Scoring can be used and tallies kept. It is also possible to use a ladder format with winners moving up and losers moving down after each round.

Set-up

- Students in pairs facing one another
- Mini whiteboard and pen each
