
9. Pass the Buck



Instructions

Students work in pairs. Each pair has a different coloured pen. Assign one person in the pair to be the scribe (the scribes can swap at any point). The teacher puts an exam question up and students have 1 minute to begin writing their answer.

Once time is up, students pass their paper along to the next pair. When students receive the new piece of paper, they read the beginning of the answer that is on the sheet

and continue the answer. By the end, each sheet will have a complete answer, with each pair's contribution showing in a different colour.

You will need to build in time for each pair to read the answer, discuss it and add their contribution to it, so the time allowed for each round will most likely need to increase to allow for the additional reading time.

Set-up

- Students sat in pairs.
- One coloured pen per pair
