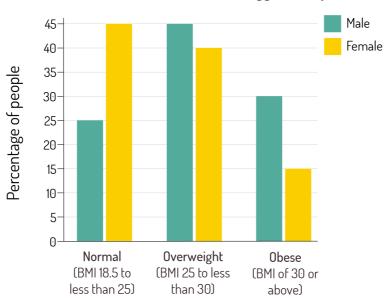
The graph shows the Body Mass Index (BMI) of adults in Wiggleton-by-Sea. Analyse the graph and make comparisons between males and females.

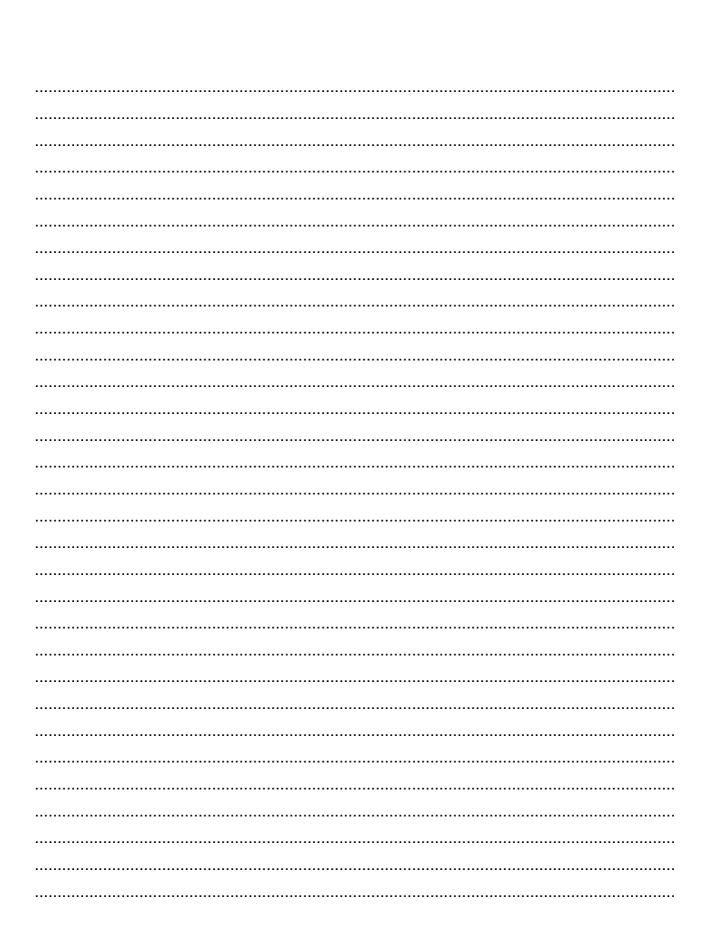

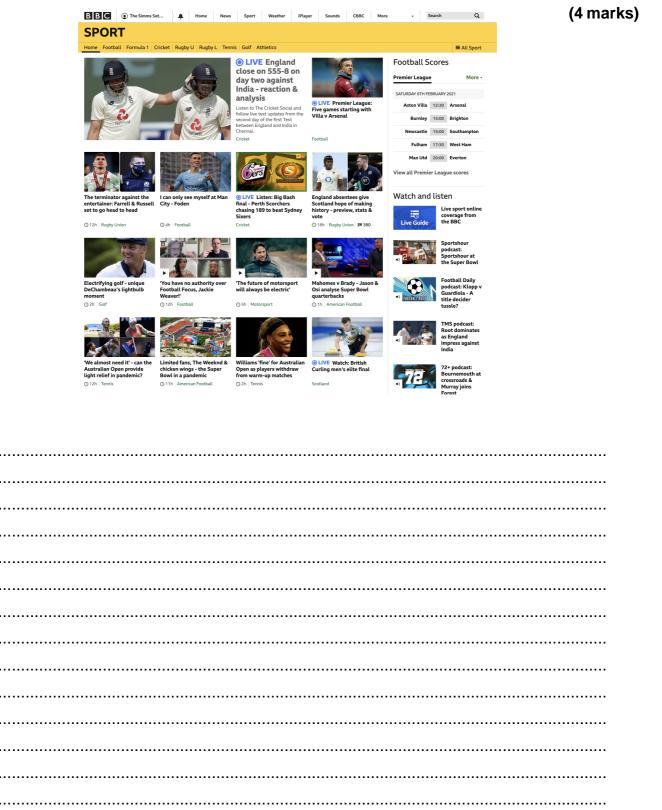
